Brief description of the position: The Department of Pediatrics is seeking an outstanding individual to join the Pediatric Infectious Disease Division at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at the Assistant or Associate level to further build our infection prevention and control (IP&C) program at our affiliated hospital, Children's Medical Center and affiliated health system, Children'sHealth as the Associate Medical Director of IP&C. This faculty member would work under and report to the Medical Director of IP&C and would be incorporated into all activities of the Department of Infection Prevention and Control at Children's Medical Center.

Clinical activities of the division, both in-patient and out-patient, are conducted at Children's Medical Center Dallas, a 487-bed hospital that is the only academic health care facility in North Texas dedicated exclusively to the comprehensive care of children. Candidates must be eligible for licensure in the state of Texas. Appointment rank will be commensurate with academic accomplishments and experience.

Candidates must have strong clinical skills and demonstrated teaching abilities in Pediatric Infectious Disease in addition to excellent interpersonal skills.
