The Division of Infectious Diseases and Global Health in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of California San Francisco (UCSF) is seeking a full-time faculty member at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor in the clinician-educator track. Candidates must have an MD, MD/PhD, or equivalent and be board certified or board eligible by the American Board of Pediatrics in the subspecialty of Pediatric Infectious Diseases.

Our Division provides inpatient and outpatient consultative services to pediatric patients at two campuses – Benioff Children's Hospital San Francisco and Benioff Children's Hospital Oakland. We are looking to recruit a faculty member with passion for clinical excellence, teaching, and innovation. There are opportunities for leadership in Hospital Epidemiology and Infection Prevention, and in Ambulatory Operations, as we expand the outpatient telemedicine service to serve areas throughout Northern California. Applicants with an interest in providing care to immunocompromised children (both transplant and primary immunodeficiency) are especially encouraged to apply. The position will also include opportunities to teach trainees of all levels. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate J-1 visas at this time.

Built in 2015, the San Francisco campus, located in the Mission Bay neighborhood, is a 183-bed non-profit pediatric-care teaching facility and serves as a major regional quaternary care center. The Oakland campus, which formally integrated with UCSF in 2014, has been delivering care to pediatric patients in the Bay Area for over 100 years. It houses one of the five Level 1 Trauma centers in California and provides tertiary care to children across the Bay Area. In 2020, UCSF Benioff Children's Hospitals ranked in all 10 children's specialties in U.S. News and World Report.
