Brief description of the position: The Division of Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Washington University in St. Louis is seeking a clinical faculty member at the Assistant or Associate Professor level to serve as Director of the Antimicrobial Stewardship Program at St. Louis Children's Hospital (a 390-bed pediatric tertiary care center) and other nearby pediatric care sites of the Department of Pediatrics. This ASP Director will work side-by-side with our experienced Pediatric ASP Pharmacist and leverage our large, state-of-the-art clinical microbiology laboratory. The position will co-direct and host the Annual International Pediatric Antimicrobial Stewardship Conference, held at Wash U in the late spring, as well as coordinate pediatric antimicrobial therapeutics across the 15-hospital BJC HealthCare system and interface with system-wide ASPs. A minority of time will be spent performing inpatient Pediatric ID consultations and/or seeing outpatients in Pediatric ID clinics.
