

Job Title: Peds ID Faculty - HIV and Immunocompromised ID

Brief description of the position: The Division of Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Washington University in St. Louis is seeking a clinical faculty member to serve as Pediatric Medical Director for the HIV Program encompassing Project ARK, Washington University and St. Louis Children's Hospital. The Pediatric HIV Medical Director will work with our large multidisciplinary team, which features adolescent medicine specialists, adult ID providers, social work, case management, pharmacy, mental health professionals, dietitians, therapy services, and many others. The position will oversee care delivery to infants, children and adolescents living with HIV, as well as perinatally exposed infants. It will also serve as PI of multiple HRSA, Ryan White, and City of St. Louis grants that fund various HIV-related services in St. Louis, greater Missouri and southern Illinois. Depending on the candidate's other activities and experience, the balance of clinical effort will be spent on our Immunocompromised ID service (inpatient and SOT outpatient) or general Peds ID services.

Qualifications you are seeking: Board eligible or board certified in Pediatrics and Pediatric Infectious Diseases Commitment to providing high-quality, compassionate care to patients and families, including embracing and reflecting diversity in the broadest sense Ability to work collaboratively with a diverse group of physicians and nonphysician professionals in outpatient and inpatient care settings Specific experience (during fellowship training or early faculty career) in perinatal and pediatric HIV and program logistics Interest and/or experience in HIV-related research (e.g., clinical or basic research, public health, implementation science) is certainly welcomed but not required.
