Brief description of the position: Academic Physician - Pediatric Infectious Diseases

Clinical duties include providing consultative pediatric infectious disease inpatient patient care, development of clinical protocols, and/or outpatient care. Other duties will include scholarly activities (clinical research, vaccine research, community-based research programs, or funded lab based research) as well as teaching and supervision of trainees and medical students. Limited off-hours and occasional weekend coverage are expected. Primary placement will be at Comer Children's Hospital in the Hyde Park neighborhood of Chicago and may include other locations affiliated with the University of Chicago. Academic rank and compensation (including a generous package of fringe benefits) is dependent on qualifications.
