Brief description of the position: We are seeking three full-time faculty members for Assistant or Associate Professor of Pediatrics. The specific track will depend on an applicant's interests and qualifications.

Clinical duties will include a balance of inpatient ID consultations and staffing in the outpatient ID clinic, tailored to the needs of the applicant and the hospital. Faculty may also engage in the Antimicrobial Stewardship Program (ASP) and Infection Prevention and Control (IPC). Additional job duties will include teaching students, residents, and pediatric ID fellows. Numerous opportunities for clinical and translational research exist but are not mandatory for these positions.

Medical providers in the CHLA ID division include physician faculty, nurse practitioners, and nurse care managers. Our ASP and IPC programs are strongly supported by the hospital and include two full-time ASP pharmacists. We have an active immunocompromised program serving the busy oncology, solid-organ, and bone marrow transplant services. We staff one of the earliest long-COVID clinics in the country. Lastly, our fellowship program has been training fellows for 25 years.
