Brief description of the position: The Infectious Diseases Division of Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center (CCHMC) seeks an MD/DO or MD-PhD faculty member at the Assistant or Associate Professor level to fill the position of Associate Medical Director of Infection Prevention and Control (IP&C). CCHMC is a vibrant academic medical center and one of the top children's hospitals in the world, with operations of >\$2.3 billion annually.

The successful candidate will join a nationally recognized and robust IP&C Program with diverse strengths, especially in quality improvement and epidemiology. Along with the current Medical Director and Associate Medical Director, the IP&C Program seeks an additional Associate Medical Director to cover the breadth of services. The IP&C Program also includes a Director of Operations, 13 Infection Preventionists, a data manager, and a program coordinator covering 675 beds and surgical, specialty and primary care ambulatory facilities. Unique aspects of the Program include a dedicated Environment of Care team and a large Behavioral Health facility. The current principal areas of growth include Ambulatory and Perioperative locations with additional expansions planned.

The ideal candidate will divide their effort between patient care and infection prevention activities, including leadership in prevention of hospital acquired infections, engagement of internal and external partners, and representing IP&C and CCHMC in public forums. The candidate will have additional designated effort to engage with Antimicrobial Stewardship (ASP) for collaboration and institutional alignment. The amount of effort for this position is 60% in IP&C, 15% in ASP, and 25% clinical, depending upon the career plans of the individual.

Academic efforts at CCHMC are supported by outstanding infrastructure and a substantial research endowment administered through the Cincinnati Children's Research Foundation. The Infectious Diseases Division has existing strengths in basic and clinical research, including in viral pathogenesis, host-microbe interactions, mechanisms of inflammation and tolerance, vaccine development and clinical trials, transplant/immunocompromised infectious diseases, infectious diseases epidemiology and surveillance, infection prevention, and antimicrobial stewardship.
